Tournament hosts are responsible for preparing for and running the NSHS speech tournament. They choose trophies, buy/create thematic decorations and organize the decorating of NSHS for the tournament. They write the group discussion and impromptu prompts, create folders for each participating school and do whatever needs to be done in advance to organize the tournament. During the tournament they handle registration as schools arrive. They help out in TAB. They are the spokespeople for NSHS, welcoming schools, making announcements, and conducting the final awards ceremony. Tournament hosts must be highly organized, friendly, flexible and responsible. Tournament hosts must also be able to work well together. This year we had two tournament hosts who were debaters and two who did speech events. I plan to do that again next year.

It is not a huge time commitment until the week of the tournament, but hosts must be in regular communication with Mrs. Honeyman during the months leading up to the tournament to be sure they are doing the things that need to be done along the way.
